UTAH NAVAJO TRUST FUND SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA (or SAN JUAN ENDOWMENT FUND at CEU-SJC)

The Utah Navajo Trust Fund (UNTF) Scholarship, and the San Juan Endowment Fund for CEU-San Juan Campus only, provides financial assistance to **eligible San Juan County, Utah** Navajos, who are pursuing their: One Year Certificate; Associate of Arts; Associate of Science; Bachelor of Science; Masters, and Doctorate degree from an accredited post-secondary institution, including vocational or technical schools.

UNTF Scholarship Assistance Check List

Applies to All Students -- Before applying for UNTF:

- A. Applicants must be a lifetime resident, having permanent homestead in San Juan County, Utah to be eligible.
- B. Have been accepted by and officially registered with your college or university.
- C. Have applied for Federal Student Aid (Pell Grant) and turned Student Aid Report (SAR) to financial aid office.
- D. Applied for the Navajo Tribal scholarship (NTS). If denied, submit denial letter. Call 1-800-243-2956 for NTS information.

NEW STUDENTS: (Never received UNTF scholarship assistance)

- 1. Verification of Residency form. Obtain from your Chapter House. Submit original, with all signatures. (No fax or xerox) Submit only once.
- 2. UNTF application. Answer all questions & sign application (see reverse side of this page upper portion). Incomplete is unacceptable.
- 3. Financial Needs Analysis (FNA) for terms you are applying for. To be completed by your financial aid office (reverse side lower portion).
- 4. Class Schedule: Submit copy after you are officially registered. Include listing of all current classes by name, with credit hours.
- 5. **Official transcript**: GED, high school, or up-to-date college official transcript. (No fax or xerox)
- 6. Consent Form. Submit once. Authorizes UNTF to check your status with Navajo Tribal Scholarship at your area Agency.

RETURNING STUDENTS: (Have been assisted by UNTF before)

- 1. **UNTF application**. Answer <u>all</u> questions & sign application (see reverse side of this page upper portion). *Incomplete is unacceptable*.
- 2. Financial Needs Analysis (FNA) for terms you are applying for. To be completed by your financial aid office (reverse side lower portion).
- 3. Class Schedule: Submit copy after you are officially registered. Include listing of all current classes by name, with credit hours.
- 4. Official transcript Up-to-date official transcript is required at the beginning of each year (copies OK after that).

Requirement: Student must be enrolled and complete 6 credit hours or more per term and maintain a 2.0 (C) or higher GPA to remain eligible.
